#### **PACT ACT:**

The Honoring our Promise to Address
Comprehensive Toxics (PACT) Act of
2022 is a new law that expands VA
health care and benefits for Veterans
exposed to burn pits and other toxic
substances. This law helps us
provide generations of Veterans—
and their survivors— with the care
and benefits they've earned and
deserve.

#### MST:

 Military sexual trauma (MST) refers to sexual assault or sexual harassment experienced during military service. Veterans can receive disability compensation, and related benefits, for conditions that started or got worse in the line of duty, including injuries or disabilities related to MST. VA provides free treatment for any physical or mental health conditions related to a Veteran's experiences of MST. Documentation of the MST experience(s) or a VA disability rating is not required to receive care.
